ABOUT BILL

William Stillman, a self-advocate with Asperger's Syndrome, has been dubbed "The Autism Whisperer," by talk show host Frankie Picasso, for his innate ability to understand and interpret children and adults on the autism spectrum. Lisa Jo Rudy, About.com's autism moderator, has said, "William Stillman is one of the few who can translate the workings of the autistic mind to the neuro-typical community."

Stillman has a B.S. in Education from Millersville University in Pennsylvania, and has worked to support people with different ways of being since 1987. He was formerly the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare, Office of Developmental Program's statewide point person for children with intellectual impairment, mental health issues, and autism.

Stillman's research for his groundbreaking **Autism and the God Connection** trilogy lead to a personal awakening and, since 2004, he has worked professionally as a psychic and spiritual counselor. His accuracy in discerning the truth and making predictions that come to fruition has been acclaimed by his clients as truly extraordinary, and ranks at 90-98% accurate.

William Stillman takes his psychic work very seriously. Before each event, he spends about 45 minutes in prayer and meditation. Of his spiritual gifts, Bill says:

"I prepare for my work as a musician or vocalist prepares for a concert or an athlete trains for a marathon. I pray throughout each day so as to raise my consciousness and elevate my awareness to attain a perpetual state of meditation".

Bill has been interviewed on numerous radio shows of a paranormal nature including **Coast to Coast AM**, the most listened to overnight radio program in North America.

Since 2006, Bill has been a recurring guest on BeyondtheOrdinary.net. He has also been a guest on the popular YouTube series, **Swedenborg and Life**.












His first book on the subject of autism, **Demystifying the Autistic Experience: A Humanistic Introduction for Parents, Caregivers and Educators (2002)**, has been highly praised by the autism and self-advocacy communities. Stillman’s other books include **Empowered Autism Parenting: Celebrating (and Defending) Your Child’s Place in the World(2009)**, a 2011 Indie Book Awards Finalist; **The Autism Answer Book (2007)**; **The Everything Parent’s Guide to Children with Asperger’s Syndrome: Help, Hope and Guidance (2005)** [a condensed version of which was published in 2008 as *When Your Child has Asperger’s Syndrome*; second revised edition published 2010]; **The Everything Parent’s Guide to Children with Bipolar Disorder: Professional, Reassuring Advice to Help You Understand and Cope (2005)**; and **The Soul of Autism (2008)** and **The Autism Prophecies (2010)**, sequels to **Autism and the God Connection**.

To date, Stillman’s writings have been translated in four languages. (Stillman is also coauthor of several successful books about his life-long passion, *The Wizard of Oz*.)
